
I don't really have any back issues left, #1 or 2, so don't send any money for those, please. Hopefully I will have both issues back in print by December.

ABALIENATION AND MDC at MAX'S june 3, 1993

I wanted to do a full fledged interview with MDC, but I didn't feel that I had enough background knowledge of the band. Besides Mike Dickinson (Abalienation) did an interview of 'em for S.M.U.N.A.G. (local punk zine). I did talk to Chris and Erica quite a bit, though. In fact I missed both the Godless Murderers' and Bad Karma's sets while I was on the deck tal ing to Chris, Erica and some local scenesters. Oh well. I didn't miss much.

Up next, third, were local punk favorites Abalienation. They opened their set with their classic tune "Lick My Krack," as always, and they continued to rip through more than a dozen high energy, "old school" hardcore songs including "Climbing Over Bodies," "Six Feet in the Dirt," and "Moral Obligation," three relatively new songs that will be on their upcoming 7 inch, if they get any recordings Bigg-Jim they likes. About three quarters of the way through their set, Mike called Dave from MDC up on stage to sing Abalienation's "Shoot Cops, Not Dope." It was fantastic, especially considering Dave didn't know the lyrics at all. Their set was most definitely the best Abalienation show in a while. There was just an incredible amount of energy passing back and forth between the band and the crowd. It made the whole show (even killing time while the first two bands were on) worth while. If you get the chance to see Abalienation live don't pass it up. You won't be disappointed! I promise.

Finally, the "headliners" MDC took the stage. They played a truly amazing set. They have to be the band that ever played at Max's. They played every song off their up coming LP (check out the lyric sheets they handed out for the new songs... they are in here somewhere) and alot of their classic tunes. 



CHAPLAINS

The High Price of Prayer

No, THIS IS not the Chaplain Corps of the armed services, an old American tradition. This has to do with God and

the U.S. Congress.

In the 1960s, the Supreme Court—drawing on the concept of separation of church and state—ruled that not even school children could be led in organized prayer at the beginning of the day. But the United States Congress is apparently immune to the verdicts of the Court and too religious to do without divine counsel.

Each session of the House and the Senate is opened with a prayer. Is it led by a pious member of the body, or some volunteer clergyman—Catholic, Protestant, or Jewish—from the community, hopeful the legislators will

see the light during their deliberations?

No, that's too simple. Everything Congress does (and the White House, too, as we shall see) has to cost money, and a lot of it. Both Houses of Congress have their own full-time, salaried Chaplains, at a stiff price to the tax-payers.

The House Chaplain gets a salary of—and this is not a typo—\$115,300. Not to be outdone, the Senate Chaplain spends much more per member-soul on his small body of 100 legislators. He receives about the same salary as his House colleague, but he has an overall budget of \$300,000, including pay for secretaries and office space to help him shepherd his sometimes wayward flock.

If it worked, it might be worth the price. But thus far there are no signs of divine intervention in the chambers

of the U.S. Congress.

Isn't it nice to know that we Americans support a separation of church and state.





FEAR OF FAILURE by Nicole Evans Chenango Forks High School September 5, 1990

Failure is something that happens to everyone and is hard on self esteem and accomplishment. Many people hide from challenge, limiting their accomplishments, fearing they might fail.

Fear of failure can be explained in many ways: Some people say that they are afraid of being evaluated and what they are actually saying is that they fear being judged, knowing they are not prepared. People who are confident of what they are being judged, obviously would not have this fear. Other people think that they have fear of failure, but actually have fear of success, being afraid of demands for continued achievement. Fear of failure is actually when people can conquer the first step but fear the continuing steps. Many people do not realize they are experiencing this, but they show the symptoms such as having difficulty assuming responsibility, making commitments, taking risks, and making decisions.

One specific study done by resarchers was to prove that women were actually afraid of success: "The researchers had ninety women and eighty-eight men write a story about a fictitious student. 65% of the women included fear of success in their stories but only 10% of the men did. Doing this, the researchers showed that many women want to be successful but fear being rejected or not filling the female role."

Other researchers suggest that girls have more fear of failure than boys because girls are less likely to learn ways to handle it. In a study, researchers found that girls who suffered from fear of failure as children also had high levels of fear of failure as adults. Boys, on the other hand, who had a high level of fear of failure as children did not necessarily have it as adults. This suggests that when growing up, boys, more than girls, ahve experiences that change the intensity of fear of failure. These experiences allow boys to manage their fear successfully and teach them responses to failure, such as playing sports and learning to get up and try again.

Some people respond to failure as a part of a learning process that allows them to do better the next time they try. Others respond to failure helplessly and because of this are more devastated and more afraid of it.

Girls tend to handle failure helplessly; because of failure they tend to lower their expectations of success. Even when conditions are changed to encourage optimism, girls' expectations still usually do not come back up. When girls' expectations are finally raised, they generally are very fragile and can be destroyed easily. This way of handling failure is definitely not the right way.

People must learn to have constructive views of failure. That means when one fails, that it doesn't mean quit, only to start all over again. The reason girls generally do not have this view of failure is because as children we are taught that failing means you did something wrong. Doing something wrong means you are bad. This is how girls' self esteem is generally cut down, therefore leaving them nowhere, with no inspiration to try again.

CHRISTIAN ALERT

BILL CLINTON'S DECISION TO LIFT THE MILITARY'S HOMOSEXUAL BAN WILL ERODE CIVILIAN AUTHORITY AND WEAKEN THE FITNESS OF OUR FORCES...UNLESS WE ACT NOW.....

President Clinton's compromise with Capital Hill means the military ban on homosexuals could fall when he signs an Executive order -unless Congress acts. The Senate on Feb. 4th rejected an amendment to keep the ban six more months, but agreed to hold hearings on the issue. Meanwhile, Rep. - *On average, have hundreds of sexual partners during a lifetime, with many having more than 1,000.

 *Continue to engage in male-male sex without condoms in dangerous numbers.
- *Continue to commit to other unhealthy sexual acts in dangerous numbers and subsequently are more likely to suffer from intestinal disorders known collectively as "gay bowel syndrome".

THREATS TO MILITARY LIFE:

The military requires intimate conditions, especially in wartime. Open homosexuality creates tension and a loss of privacy. Military families with children would compete with homosexuals for housing, medical care and relocation benefits.

A coalition of gay groups has prepared a plan that would drop HIV testing of all recruits and would require the Pentagon to conduct "indoctrination" programs for all heterosexual military personnel to ensure their acceptance of gays and lesbians. It makes no difference that many will have religious or moral objections to the instruction.

Lifting the ban would lead to affirmative action for promotions of homosexuals in the military and would legitimate homosexual behavior for society as a whole. The military would be distracted from its mission of defending America and become a giant engine for radical social change.

As Commander-in-chief, Bill Clinton needs to know that radical homosexual activists do not speak for military families. He needs to know they do not speak for the majority of Americans. 


